COURSE DESCRIPTION

This one-day seminar will cover Special Inspection requirements for Proprietary Anchor installation. Installation of post-installed adhesive and mechanical anchors is required to have Special Inspection per International Building Code. The Washington Association of Building Officials (WABO) offers a Proprietary Anchors (PA) Special Inspection certification. This course and instructor offered by the NWCEL has been approved by WABO to meet this requirement. Students must pass the course exam to receive credit for this course. Note: retake exams will not be offered for this course.

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTOR

Jeremy Christensen is an ICC and WABO certified Special Inspector with over 24 years of experience in inspection and testing. Mr. Christensen began his career in Alaska as a lab technician and eventually become a Special Inspector.
